Corey Riendeau, an NHTI alum, the warden of the Northern New Hampshire Correctional Facility in Berlin since 2018.

Riendeau credits NHTI for providing a practical foundation to launch his career. "The professors I had were working or had worked in the field, so you got a real-life perspective." Having the police academy adjacent to campus

also provided a unique opportunity for students to see what it would be like to be a recruit.

He also serves on an advisory committee for White Mountains Community College (WMCC) in Berlin. He and other committee members provide feedback about the curriculum and help spread the word about WMCC. "It's a collaboration," Corey says. "I'm always thinking about recruitment and retention (at the prison)...I had no idea how much the community college actually does and how much they invest in their students."
